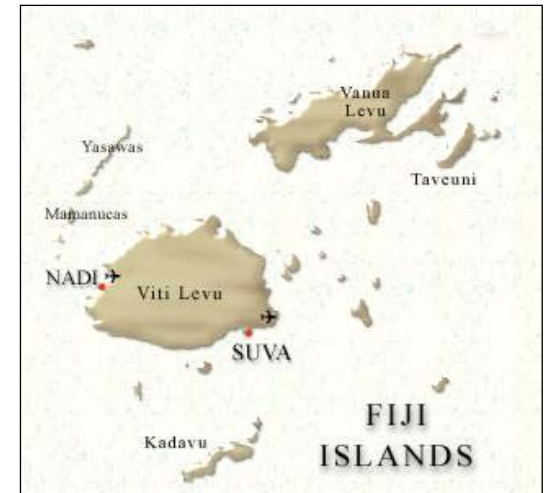

Fiji:



Fiji has a population of over 936,000:

Fijian (Melanesian) - about 50%, speaking six related main languages and 30 dialects.

Indian etc- about 46%, mainly from indentured labour imported by the British between 1879 and 1916. They speak primarily Fiji Hindu.

The major earnings are from tourism and sugar.

There has been past ethnic tension between the indigenous Fijians and immigrant Indians. Although Fijians embraced Christianity over a century ago, this was often cultural rather than spiritual. Most of the Indian population in Fiji has yet to be evangelised.

The need for the gospel is great in Fiji.
